

In addition to our pilgrimage to Oberammergau, Germany, we will visit Prague, Český Krumlov, Vienna, Salzburg, and Munich. Discover the remarkable history of Jan Hus and the Czech Reformation in Prague. Tour awe-inspiring Gothic cathedrals and become enchanted by opera houses, numerous imperial palaces and fortresses, including Prague Castle, the Schönbrunn and Hofburg (homes of the Hapbsurgs and rulers of the Holy Roman and Austro-Hungarian Empires), and much more!

Visit the birthplace of Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart in Vienna with optional Sound of Music tour in Salzburg, in addition to other optional excursions during your free time. We will also ascend the Bavarian Alps to see the inspiring fairytale Neuschwanstein Castle of "Mad King" Ludwig, the inspiration and pattern for Walt Disney's magic kingdom.

Trip will include daily devotions and weekend worship service. Fly round trip from Denver.

YOUR DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

TUE, MAY 24 - ACROSS THE ATLANTIC

Depart Denver on board your overnight transatlantic jet flight. Enroute, enjoy a meal followed by a full-length movie.

WED, MAY 25 - ARRIVE PRAGUE

Arrive in historic, 1,000-year-old Prague on the Vltava River where you will be met and escorted to your waiting motorcoach for the transfer to your hotel. (D)

THU, MAY 26 - PRAGUE

This morning experience the 1000 years of Prague's history with a visit to Hradcany Castle, the seat of power for several Czech princes and kings. Proceed to the Gothic St. Vitus Cathedral, the Romanesque Basilica of St. George and Mala Strana (Lesser Town), whose winding streets are lined with small taverns and old houses. You will also see the 1618 Defenestration window, St. Michael's Church and Bethlehem Chapel. Continue to Old Town to see the ancient Town Hall with its animated astronomical clock. The afternoon is at leisure to shop or to visit a local brewery. (B,D)

FRI, MAY 27 – PRAGUE/ĈESKÝ KRUMLOV/VIENNA

Bidding farewell to the Czech Republic's enchanting capital, travel through the south Bohemian countryside, passing picturesque villages and ponds, to Ĉeský Krumlov. Known as 'the Pearl of the Renaissance', the State Castle of Ĉeský Krumlov is one of the most important historic sites in Central Europe. Following a panoramic tour, continue across the border into Austria proceeding to Vienna, once the center of the mighty Hapsburg Empire. A unique European metropolis, the city itself contains more than a million inhabitants and is set in beautiful surroundings. This afternoon is at leisure to shop or to visit a local brewery. (B,D)



SAT, MAY 28 – VIENNA

This morning enjoy a sightseeing tour of Vienna beginning with a drive around the Ringstrasse, one of the most magnificent boulevards in the world. It encloses the Inner City and such noble edifices as the Votive Church, built in 1856, the University, the City Hall and the Opera House. Continue to Schönbrunn Palace with its glorious French Park. The Palace has 1400 rooms and halls, a small zoo and a fine museum of state coaches. Also visit Hofburg Castle, the former imperial palace. Your afternoon is at leisure for shopping or exploring on your own. Perhaps see a Marionette performance at the Schönbrunn Palace. (B)

SUN, MAY 29 - VIENNA

Today is free to enjoy all Vienna has to offer including its cultural and art treasures along with its coffee-house culture and vibrant epicurean scene. (B)

MON, MAY 30 - VIENNA/SALZKAMMERGUT/SALZBURG

Enjoy views of the scenic Austrian countryside on your drive this morning. Enjoy a tour of the Austrian resort area of Salzkammergut including the charming towns of St. Wolfgang and Mondsee. See Alpine lakes, picturesque valleys and rugged mountains. Continue to the "Sound of Music" city of Salzburg, one of the world's most beautiful places. (B,D)

TUE, MAY 31- SALZBURG

This morning your tour of Salzburg will take you past the most beautiful sights of the city. Drive via the Schloss Mirabell and the Kongresshaus. Continue via Schwarzstrasse and the Protestant Church to the Mozarteum and then past the Marionetten Theatre, Landes Theatre, Marktplatz, and Rathaus to view where Mozart was born. The afternoon is free to shop or to take an optional Sound of Music tour. (B)

WED, JUN 1 – SALZBURG/MUNICH

Today cross the border into Germany for Munich, the capital of Bavaria. Your orientation tour of Munich takes you via

Karolinenplatz and past the 1000-foot-high Television Tower to Nymphenburg, the former Royal Residence. Drive on to Marienplatz to see the Rathaus-Glockenspiel of Munich then to Odeon Square with the beautiful Theatiner Church and the Hall of Generals. Balance of day is at leisure. Overnight in Munich area. (B,D)

THU, JUN 2 – MUNICH/NEUSCHWANSTEIN/MUNICH

This morning ascend the Bavarian Alps for a panoramic view of Mad King Ludwig's fairy-tale Neuschwanstein Castle, one of the most photographed palaces in the world and the model for the castles at the Walt Disney theme parks. Next visit the unusual, oval rococo Wies Church designed in the late 1740s. Return to Munich area for the overnight. (B,D)

FRI, JUN 3 – THE PASSION PLAY OF OBERAMMERGAU

The highlight of your trip! In keeping with their 387-year-old promise, the villagers of Oberammergau present their Passion Play depicting the last week of the life of Christ. The play's presentation can be traced to 1633 when the Black Plague swept Europe. The people of Oberammergau took a solemn oath: if God spared them, they would present a day-long play depicting the last week in the life of Christ. To this day they have kept their promise and every ten years the citizens of Oberammergau perform their passion play with the same love and devotion they have shown for over 380 years. Today the play takes place on an open-air stage with a covered auditorium seating 4,700, against a beautiful backdrop of towering Alpine mountains.

SAT, JUN 4 – OBERAMMERGAU/MUNICH/DENVER

Your journey is over as you transfer to Munich Airport and board your return flight back to United States, arriving Denver the same day.
